U.S. Permian natgas flaring could rise in 2024, report shows

May 23 (Reuters) - Natural gas flaring in the top U.S. shale basin is poised to increase next year, a report released on Tuesday projected, as the region's output exceeds available pipeline capacity. Increased flaring, or the burning of unwanted gas, could reduce shale oil production in the region as major oil producing companies seek to limit climate-warming carbon dioxide emissions. The Permian is the biggest U.S. shale oil basin, pumping 5.7 million barrels of oil per day and 22.5 billion cubic feet per day (bcfd) of natural gas, productivity estimates by the U.S. Energy Information Administration (EIA) show. Companies need to move that gas to market (or burn or reinject it) to sustain oil production. Natural-gasfutures drop more than 7%; oil prices end higher

Natural-gas futures fell by more than 7% on Monday, ending lower after a hefty gain last week on signs of an upcoming decline in U.S. production, while oil prices settled a bit higher as investors tracked U.S. debt-ceiling talks. Natural-gas futures ended sharply lower Monday, with prices losing more than half of the percentage gain they logged last week. The Energy Information Administration on Thursday reported a smaller-than-expected build in U.S. natural-gas supplies in storage. That "exacerbated a short-covering-driven rally" in Henry Hub, the distribution hub for natural gas, that started the week prior, analysts at Goldman Sachs wrote in a research note dated Sunday. Natural gas prices in Asia fall to pre-Ukraine war levels on China shift

TOKYO – A benchmark for natural gas prices in Asia has dropped to levels last seen before Russia's February 2022 invasion of Ukraine as China, one of the world's biggest consumers of the fuel, changes its buying patterns. The Refinitiv-calculated spot price for liquefied natural gas in Asia dipped to \$9.80 per million British thermal units on Friday, falling below \$10 for the first time since May 2021. The price is down about 90% since hitting the \$70 range last summer. Similar declines have been seen in European gas futures. Dutch TTF next-month delivery prices touched 29.75 euros (\$32) per megawatthour on Thursday, slipping below 30 euros for the first time in almost two years.... 
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


