

US natgas edges up as hot weather forecasts offset higher output

U.S. natural gas futures edged higher on Tuesday as hotter than normal weather kept air conditioning demand high, especially in Texas, offsetting pressure from rising output. Front-month gas futures for September delivery on the New York Mercantile Exchange were up 1.9 cents, or 0.7%, to \$2.74 per million British thermal units (mmBtu) at 10:07 a.m. EDT (1407 GMT). Warmer than normal temperatures in the densely populated states, continued heat in Texas, and indications that LNG export facilities are ramping up in anticipation of higher winter demand - are all providing a more stable and supportive market for prices, said Gary Cunningham, director of market research at Tradition Energy. Govt to sign 15-year LNG import deals with US Excelerate, Summit

The cabinet committee on economic affairs in a meeting on Wednesday agreed in principle with two proposals from state-owned Petrobangla to sign long-term deals with two companies for importing liquefied natural gas. The companies are Excelerate Energy Bangladesh Ltd, a subsidiary of US-based Excelerate Energy, and Summit Oil and Shipping Co Ltd, a Dhaka-based public limited company of the Summit Group.The meeting presided over by finance minister AHM Mustafa Kamal agreed in principle to sign contacts with the companies for 15 years, said Md Amin UI Ahsan, an additional secretary of the cabinet division, at an online briefing. The companies will start supplying LNG from 2026, he said.he officials also said the Petrobangla was planning to import 1 to 1.5 million tonnes of LNG per annum to be... Traders Keep Piling Into Natural Gas Futures

Energy has been a large topic in several of the recent Thrasher Analytics letters, both from a sector and commodity standpoint. One of the energy-related charts shared in Sunday's letter to subscribers looked at the Commitment of Traders (COT) data for Natural Gas futures. The report is broken up by trade size into Large Traders, Commercial Traders, and Small Traders (terminology can vary but this keeps things simple) Large Traders, which are mostly CTAs/hedge funds/ some institutions (while Commercial Traders are firms or companies that often use the underlying commodity within their business and often use futures to hedge their exposure).We can see historically that Large Traders net position has a strong correlation to the price direction of natural gas prices. ... 
