

Mother Nature is playing a double game with the natural gas market. The question is, which one will win? On one end, the summer heat isn't giving up, not even in late August amid the approach of the Sept 4 Labor Day holiday that unofficially ushers in the fall season. That could keep air-conditioning demand and — most importantly — power burns up over the next four to six weeks. Woodside, unions reach deal at Australian LNG facility

SYDNEY/SINGAPORE, Aug 24 (Reuters) - Woodside Energy (WDS.AX) on Thursday reached an in-principle agreement with unions at Australia's largest liquefied natural gas (LNG) project, potentially averting a disruption to supplies from one of the world's biggest exporters of the super-chilled fuel. The agreement caused a sharp fall in Dutch and British wholesale gas prices on Thursday, with the benchmark Dutch September contract shedding 11.5%, after hitting a two week-low earlier. The project in Western Australia, along with the Gorgon and Wheatstone LNG facilities of Chevron Corp (CVX.N), account for about one-tenth of global supplies. Both Woodside and the union alliance representing workers at the offshore platforms of its North West Shelf facility announced the initial deal in separate sta... Natural Gas Prices Forecast: Weather and Storage Reports

U.S. natural gas prices have dwindled for three consecutive sessions, reaching their most modest since mid-June, with weather patterns driving the market sentiment. While the ongoing heatwave across the nation has been factored into the prices for some time, predictions hint at milder temperatures in the upcoming week. Current scorching temperatures sweeping the nation are set to continue with highs ranging between mid-90s to 100s, signaling strong national demand. However, from August 27-31, the U.S. will experience slightly above-average temperatures, with hotter conditions making a comeback in early September. The imminent break in the ongoing heat, particularly in the Great Lakes, Ohio Valley, and Northeast regions, might dampen the high demand seen so far. Anticipation is building for... 




WEEKLY GAS IN UNDERGROUND STORAGE WITH 5-YR RANGE


