

Natural Gas Prices Forecast: Gulf Weather, Australian Strikes

Natural gas futures spiked significantly as speculators considered potential impacts of a hurricane in the Gulf of Mexico on key production plants. Despite the storm's eastward trajectory, it is the western Gulf that houses these crucial facilities. While the U.S. National Hurricane Center warns of potential intensification of Tropical Storm Idalia towards Florida, power outages in the state could have bearish consequences for natural gas prices, given Florida's reliance on gas for electricity. Further influencing global natural gas dynamics, Chevron's workers in Australia are on the brink of authorizing unions to call strikes at major liquefied natural gas (LNG) facilities. Chevron's Australia LNG ops could face daily 10-hr stoppages

SYDNEY/SINGAPORE, Aug 29 (Reuters) - Chevron's (CVX.N) two major liquefied natural gas (LNG) production facilities in Australia could face daily work stoppages of up to 10 hours next week after unions on Tuesday threatened labour action in a dispute over pay and conditions. Chevron's Gorgon and Wheatstone projects account for more than 5% of global LNG capacity, and news of the possible strikes sent European natural gas prices surging. Workers at Gorgon and Wheatstone downstream facilities plan to stop work for seven hours in two blocks on Sept. 7, escalating to 10 hours on Sept. 8 and 11 hours on Sept. 9, according to a document on the planned actions reviewed by Reuters. A smaller stoppage of three hours is planned at the Wheatstone production platform from Sept. 7, said the document, wh... For more info go to https://shorturl.at/swIU5

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




