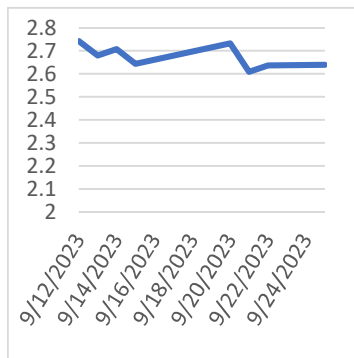

**US natgas futures settle steady; demand healthy but LNG flows drop**

U.S. natural gas futures settled steady on Monday, as less gas flowing to the nation's liquefied natural gas (LNG) export plants offset support from healthy demand projections. Front-month gas futures NGc1 for October delivery on the New York Mercantile Exchange settled little changed at \$2.639 per million British thermal units. Reduced flows from LNG feed due to maintenance were offset by some overall elevated domestic natural gas consumption, said Gary Cunningham, director of market research at Tradition Energy. Berkshire Hathaway Energy's 0.8-bcf/d Cove Point in Maryland was shut for annual maintenance. Meteorologists forecast the weather in the Lower 48 states would remain warmer than usual for the next 15 days. **Mexico's first LNG plant to receive final piece in days**

The last major piece of infrastructure needed to start production at Mexico's first floating liquefied natural gas (LNG) plant is set to depart from a Texas shipyard next week, the U.S. Coast Guard said in a notice to shippers. LNG developer New Fortress Energy is planning to begin production at the 1.4-million-tons-per-year floating plant off the coast of Altamira, Mexico, in the coming weeks. The company had in August said the first cargo from the project should depart in October. The first of three rigs that will compose the floating LNG facility arrived in Mexican waters in late August. The second departed last week from Kiewit Offshore Services' Ingleside, Texas, shipyard, according to the Coast Guard. New Fortress did not immediately reply to a request for comment. **EU countries are purchasing more LNG from Russia**

Europe again risks becoming dependent on Russian LNG. EU countries are purchasing more gas from Russia than before the Ukrainian conflict. From January to July, they purchased 40% more raw materials from it compared to the same period in 2021, Chinese publication Sina writes. On August 30, the non-governmental organization Global Witness said that in the first seven months of 2023, European Union countries spent almost 5.3 billion euros purchasing liquefied natural gas (LNG) from Russia, accounting for more than half of total imports. At the same time, Spain and Belgium have become the second and third largest buyers of Russian LNG in the world. Global Witness also found that EU members are now purchasing far more liquefied natural gas from Russia than before the Ukrainian conflict erupted... For more info go to <https://shorturl.at/fj0l0>

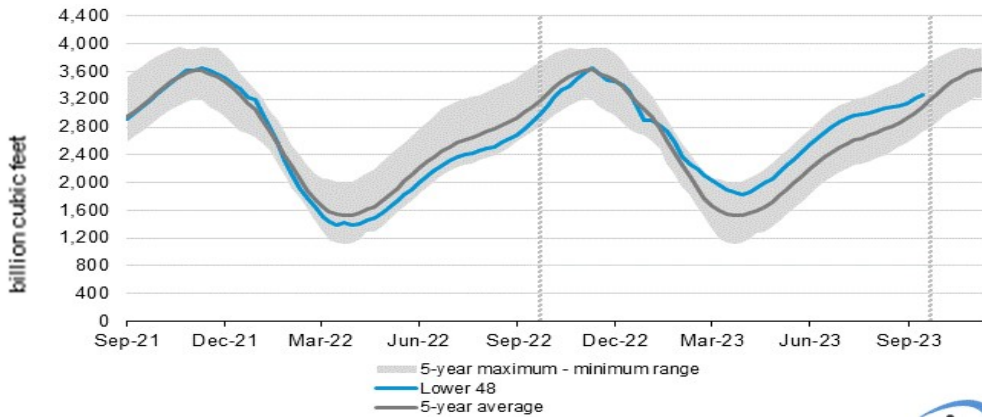

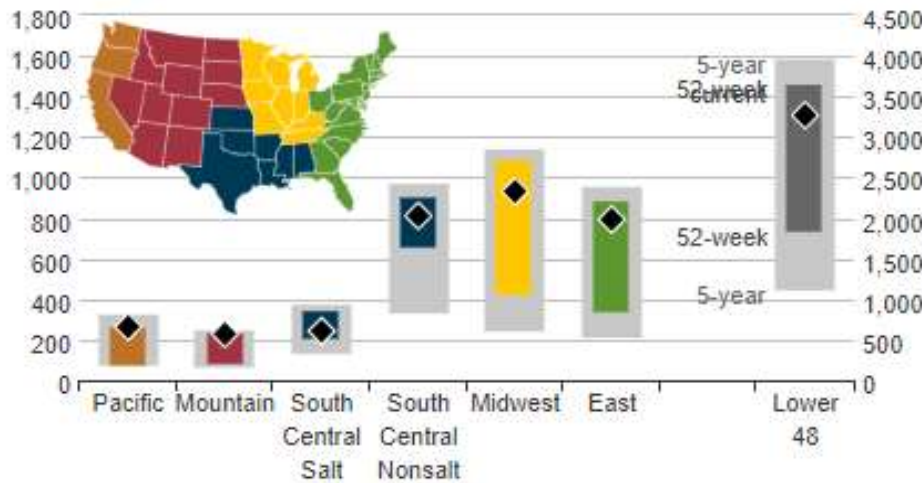

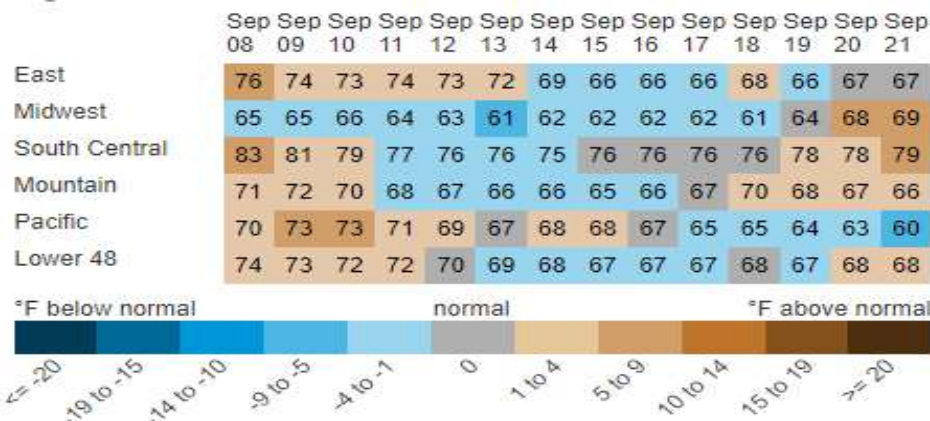

## REGIONAL AVG TEMPERATURES AND DEPARTURE FROM NORMAL



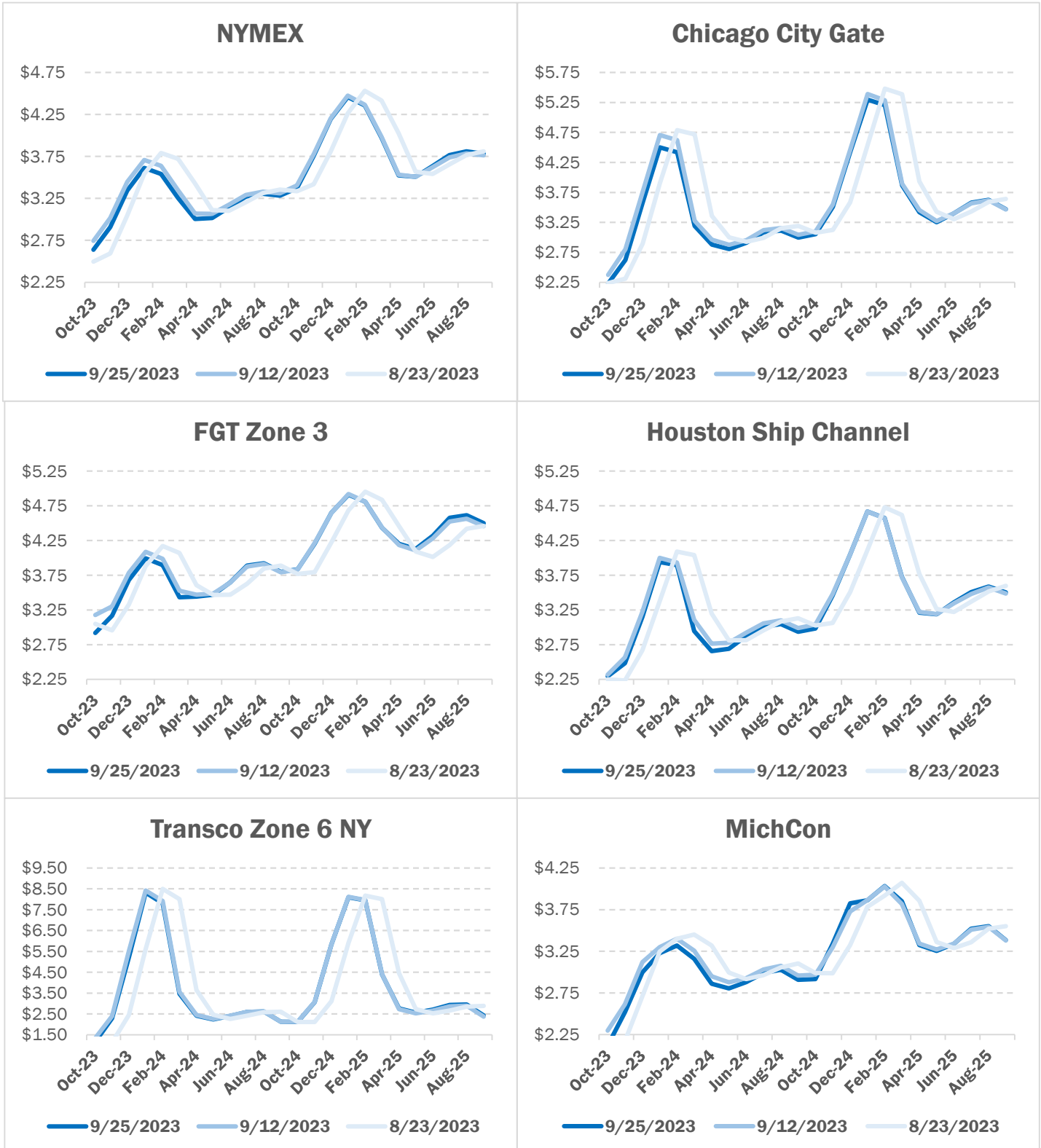

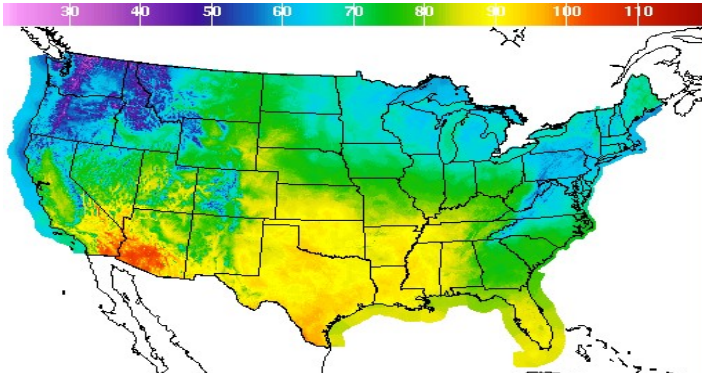

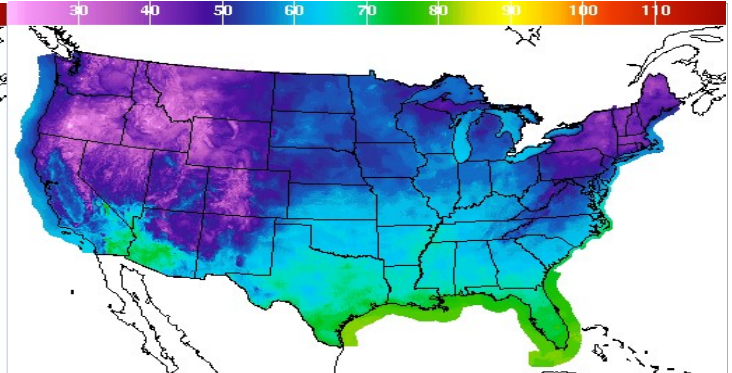
### HIGH Temperature

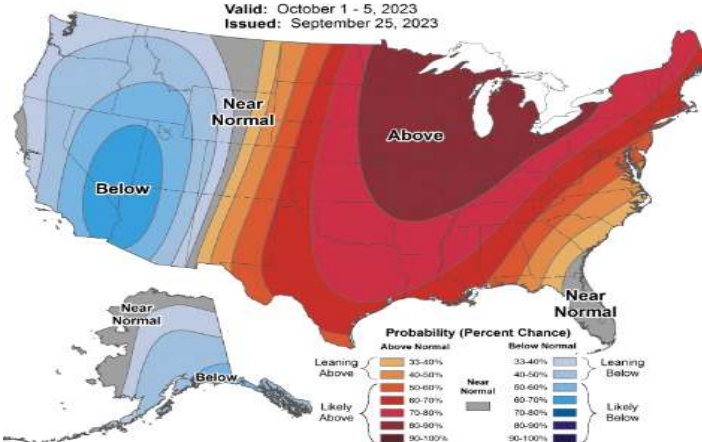

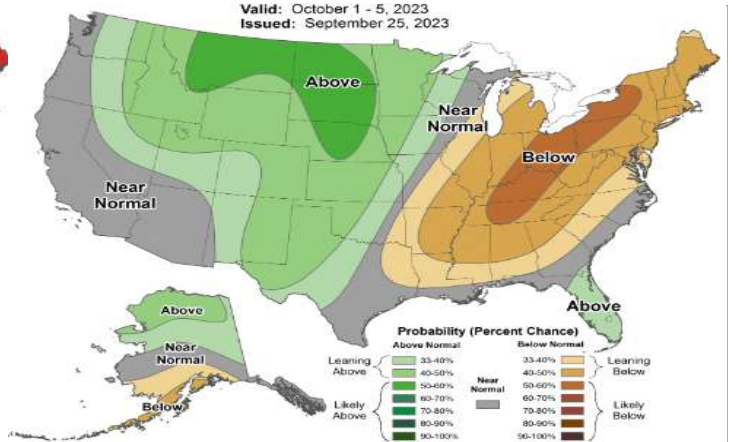
