

US natgas prices edge up 1% ahead of weekly storage

U.S. natural gas futures edged up about 1% to a nine-week high on Thursday on forecasts for more demand this week than previously expected. That increase came ahead of a federal storage report expected to show a near-normal build last week and forecasts for milder weather and less demand next week than previously expected. Analysts forecast U.S. utilities added 88 billion cubic feet (bcf) of gas into storage during the week ended Sept. 22. That compares with an increase of 103 bcf in the same week last year and a five-year (2018-2022) average increase of 84 bcf. If correct, last week's increase would boost stockpiles to 3.357 trillion cubic feet (tcf), or 5.9% above the five-year average of 3.170 tcf for the time of year. Joint venture to develop first LNG ship bunkering hub in

A joint venture is developing the first dedicated liquefied natural gas (LNG) bunkering facility for ships in the U.S. Gulf amid efforts by the maritime industry to find cleaner fuel solutions, executives said on Thursday. Shipping, which accounts for nearly 3% of global CO2 emissions and is under pressure from investors and environmental groups to accelerate decarbonisation, is exploring a number of other technologies including ammonia, methanol and wind in an effort to move away from dirtier bunker fuel. Seapath, a subsidiary of global business group Libra, and Houston-based energy infrastructure company Pilot LNG have formed a joint venture to develop, construct, and operate the LNG bunkering facility in the greater Houston/Galveston area of Texas, with operations set to begin in early 2... Natural Gas Prices Forecast: EIA Storage Data Reveals

The anticipation in the market is palpable as traders keenly await today's US government weekly storage report for US natural gas futures. If the consensus holds true, we could be looking at a build of 90 Bcf – a significant jump from last week's 64 Bcf. Current data from the EIA reveals that working gas in storage is at 3,269 Bcf, sitting comfortably within the five-year historical range. Stocks were 410 Bcf higher than last year at this time and 183 Bcf above the five-year average of 3,086 Bcf.While the southern US basks in warmth, the rest of the country will experience milder temperatures. According to NatGasWeather, this translates to a generally low demand for gas over the coming week. Wednesday was a testament to the volatile nature of gas futures, as they soared nearly 4% to touch ... For more info go to https://shorturl.at/aekX7






WEEKLY GAS IN UNDERGROUND STORAGE WITH 5-YR RANGE
