

Natural Gas Prices Forecast: Traders Brace

U.S. natural gas futures are facing a bearish outlook as market trends shift in response to changing weather patterns, supply factors, and the highly anticipated release of the latest U.S. Energy Information (EIA) Weekly Storage Report. Warmer Weather Ahead: Weather forecasts are pointing to a significant warming trend arriving in late January. This shift is expected to reduce heating demand for natural gas, putting downward pressure on prices. LNG Export Decline: Natural gas flows to U.S. liquefied natural gas (LNG) export plants recently hit a one-year low. Energy companies are redirecting gas supplies to the domestic market due to higher power gas prices caused by extreme cold, leading to decreased exports. US natural gas supplies drop, record demand forecast

Jan 15 (Reuters) - U.S. natural gas supplies have fallen by the most in over a year as extreme cold froze wells, while heating demand was on track to hit a record on Tuesday and lift both power and gas prices to multi-year highs. The Arctic blast sent temperatures plummeting across a vast swath of the U.S., leading to power outages in the Pacific Northwest and elsewhere, and snarling everything from political campaigning to football games and travel. Analysts boosted earlier forecasts for record gas demand on Tuesday but reduced their outlook for gas use on Monday, in part because many businesses and government offices will remain shut for the long U.S. Martin Luther King Jr. Day holiday weekend. Natural Gas in the red with global economic

Natural Gas (XNG/USD) is sinking lower with the US session coming in, with a tug-of-war where 2024 is seen as a lost year with a global economic slowdown. Gas supply is still very much solid and flowing, though there are a few elements that are starting to worry traders. The biggest factor is the escalation of tensions in Yemen, with more strikes in the Red Sea, and Iran attacking Pakistan. Meanwhile, the US Dollar (USD) is playing with fire after the Greenback has been on a tear all week. In the late hours of the US closing bell on Wednesday, the US Dollar Index (DXY) retreated and failed to hold ground above two important technical supports. This means that the lifecycle of this recent US Dollar strength could be short-lived. Frost in Texas and Louisiana is making it impossible to load U... 




