

Norway's Natural Gas Production Hits Record High

Norway's natural gas production beat forecasts and rose to a record high in December, preliminary figures from the Norwegian Offshore Directorate showed on Tuesday. Norwegian gas production increased to an all-time high of 379 million cubic meters per day (mcm/day), up from November levels and up by 7.7% compared to the directorate's forecast. Oil production also beat forecasts, by 1.9%, and stood at 1.847 million barrels per day (bpd) last month, up from 1.805 million bpd in November. Last year, Norway's oil and gas production was slightly lower than expected, largely due to unplanned and extended maintenance shutdowns at multiple fields and onshore facilities during the summer, the Norwegian Offshore Directorate said in its annual report earlier this month. Natural Gas Prices Forecast: Bearish Outlook

Natural gas futures show consolidation within previous range. Weather trends significantly impact natural gas prices. Short-term natural gas outlook remains predominantly bearish. U.S. natural gas futures are showing signs of consolidation, trading within the previous day's range. As of 12:59 GMT, prices stood at \$2.392, down by 1.12%. This movement suggests a cautious market stance, with traders taking profits after a recent 25%+ sell-off and Monday's gap lower opening. The market is also responding to technically oversold conditions, hinting at a potential bottoming action. NatGasWeather analysis highlights the impact of weather trends on natural gas prices. Natural Gas speeds up decline in US

Natural Gas (XNG/USD) is flirting with a fresh low for the year, with Red Sea attacks circumvented by passing around Cape of Good Hope. Gas prices are hitting the floor again near \$2.10 before another steep decline occurs. Despite being technically oversold, more of a downturn could be at hand with Gas exporters unable to ramp prices up while the demand-supply balance is still tilted into oversupply. Meanwhile, the US Dollar (USD) is hanging by a thread ahead of some main catalytic events that certainly will move the needle for the US Dollar. Although the US Dollar Index (DXY) is holding above 103, selling pressure is building with lower highs and lower lows on a daily chart.
