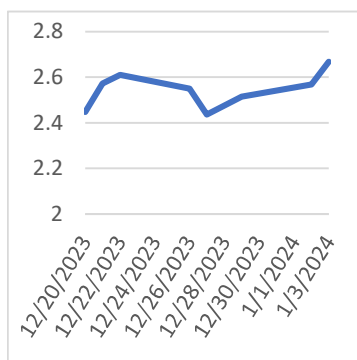

LNG Exports Raise Natural Gas Prices for Americans

Natural gas production in the United States has spiked since the fracking boom of the mid-2000s, with about two-thirds of total production coming from Texas, Pennsylvania, Louisiana, and West Virginia— typically transported by pipeline to power plants and home furnaces throughout the country. Domestic natural gas supply and demand have generally tracked one another, and the relatively small amount of international trade has consisted primarily of imports via pipelines from Canada. But the boom in new liquified natural gas (LNG) export terminals has changed these economics and is increasingly tying domestic gas prices to global markets. As with crude oil, increasing LNG exports will cause U.S. natural gas prices to be set on the international market, meaning that domestic prices will be subject to global price fluctuation. U.S. Now World's Largest LNG Exporter

The United States is now the world's LNG exporter, after overtaking Australia and Qatar, according to new data compiled and shared by Bloomberg on Tuesday. The United States exported 91.2 million metric tons of LNG last year, after the country's primary export facility, Freeport LNG, resumed operations after an eight-month hiatus following a fire in June 2022. Meanwhile, EU countries were looking to reduce their reliance on Russian gas and compensate for Russia's curtailment of pipeline gas into Europe. Australia was the second-leading LNG exporter in 2023, while Qatar, the leading LNG exporter in 2022, reduced its exports by 1.9% in 2023, came in third. This year is shaping up to be another banner year for U.S. LNG. Venture Global LNG Inc. is set to start up a new Plaquemines LNG facility... For more info go to <https://shorturl.at/fwIV9>

GT Volce: US hegemony in LNG calls for higher Chinese vigilance

As natural gas plays an increasingly important role in the global energy transition and global energy trade, the strengthened position the US has taken in the global liquefied natural gas (LNG) market has become an urgent reminder that vigilance is needed as to the impact of Washington's growing energy hegemony and potential measures it may take to strengthen or maintain that hegemony. The US has become the world's biggest LNG exporter for the first time, with 2023 shipments overtaking leading suppliers Australia and Qatar, Bloomberg reported on Wednesday. The US exported 91.2 million metric tons of LNG in 2023, a record for the country, according to data through the end of 2023 compiled by Bloomberg. 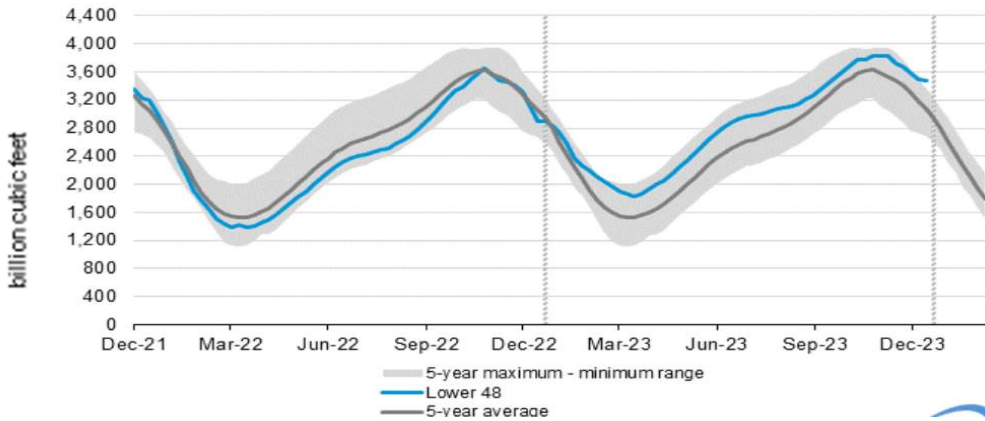

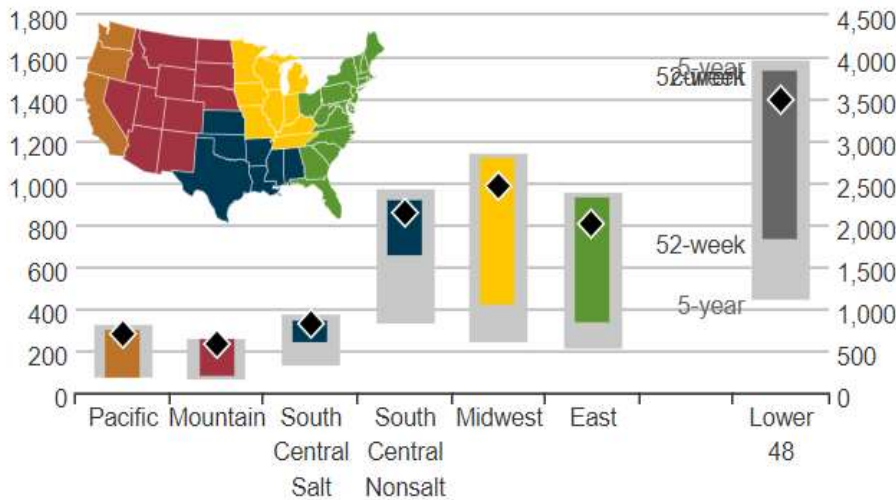

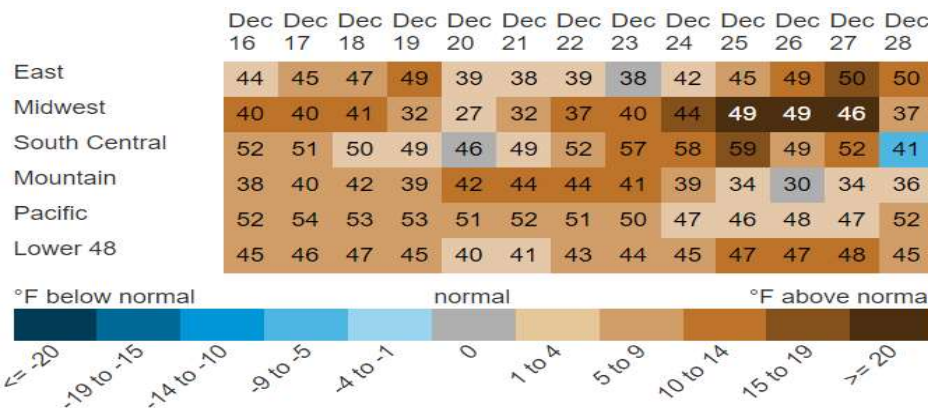

REGIONAL AVG TEMPERATURES AND DEPARTURE FROM NORMAL



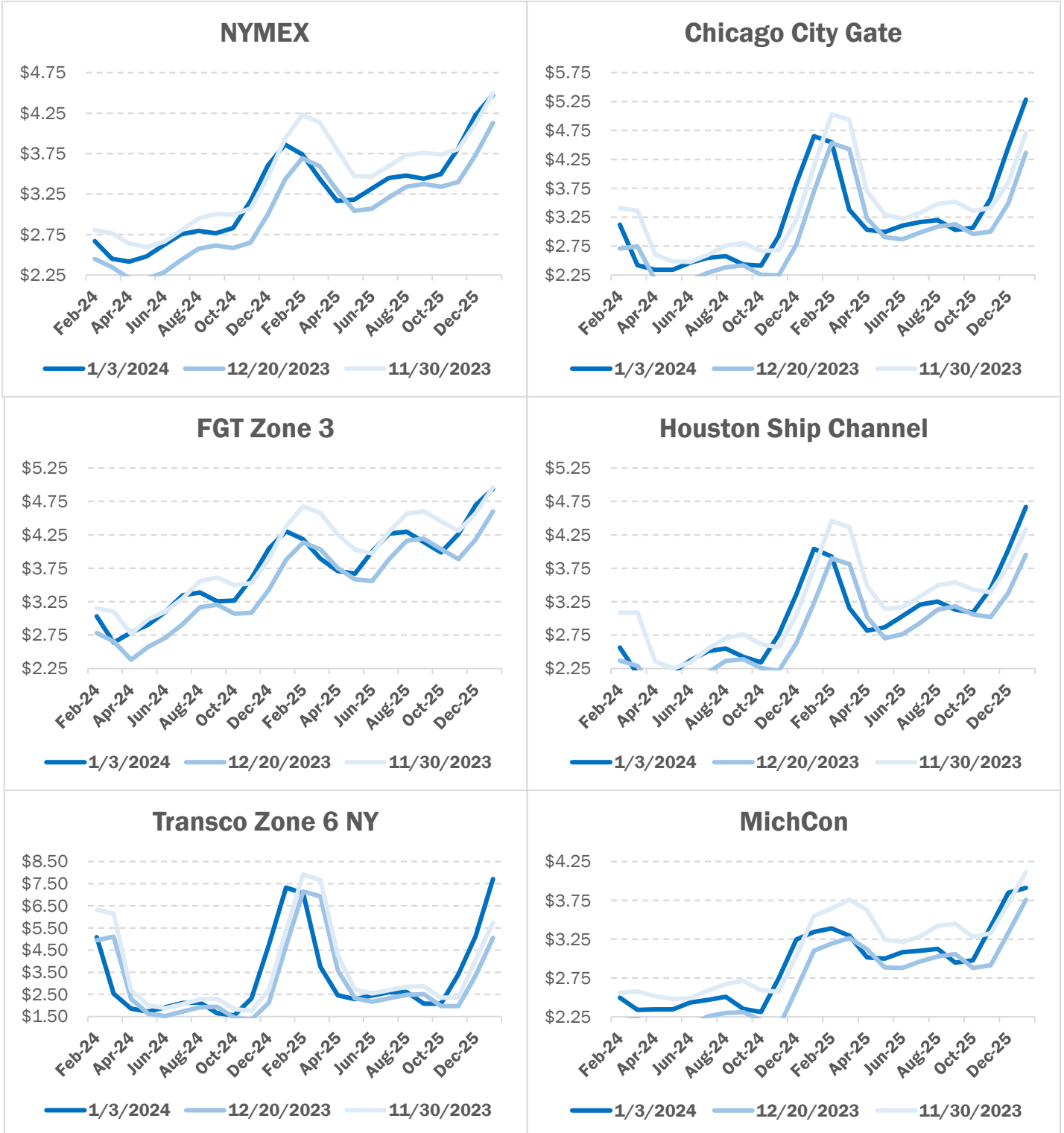

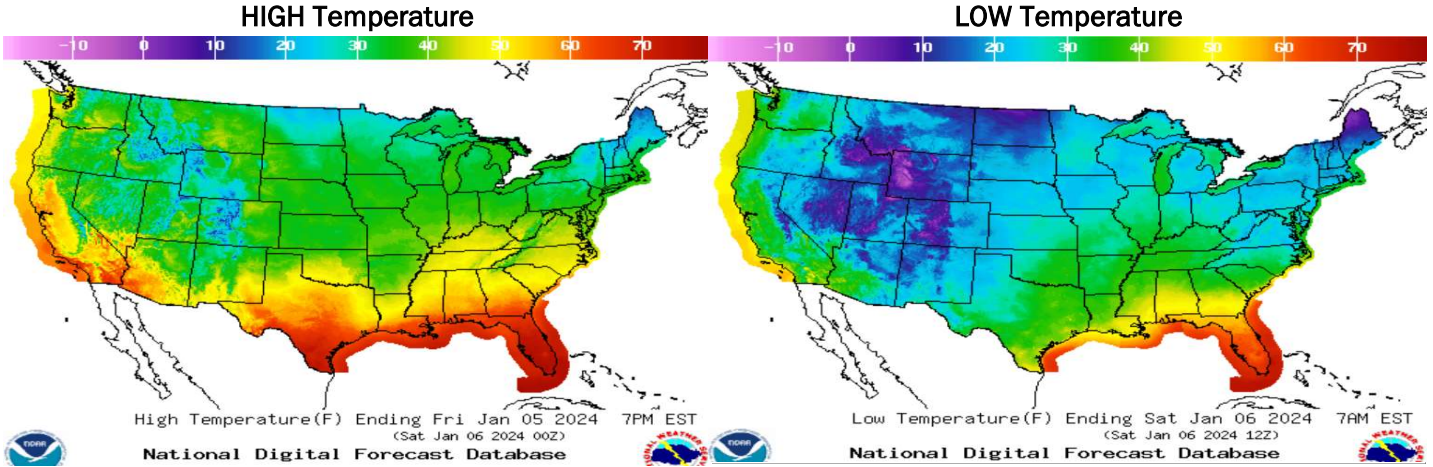
NATURAL GAS BASIS FUTURES



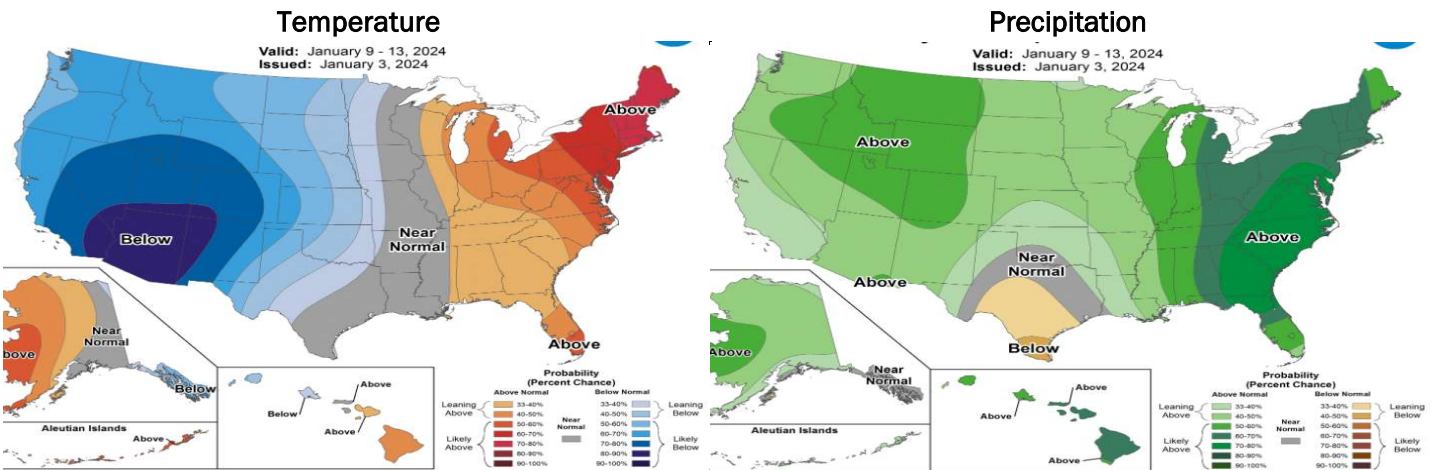
