

#### **Steady as Traders Weigh Production and Heat Trends**

Natural gas futures decline as technical pressures and fundamental factors drive sell-offs. Last week, the EIA reported a 78 Bcf storage injection, below forecast, with production up amid higher prices. Heatwave boosts Texas power usage; cooler northern U.S. forecasts reduce gas demand. U.S. natural gas futures are flat on Tuesday after recovering from early session weakness. Coming off heavy selling late last week, natural gas futures were nearly unchanged early Tuesday as traders considered stronger production and mixed June forecast trends ahead of the front-month contract expiration. At 14:01 GMT, Natural Gas futures are trading \$2.518, unchanged. Last week, U.S. natural gas futures experienced a significant decline due to technical pressures and fundamental factors. #### Natural Gas up nearly 3% on its road to recovery

Natural Gas price (XNG/USD) holds its ground on Monday after reaching a six-month high of \$3.16 on Thursday and immediately facing profit taking. The last squeeze came on the back of a Bloomberg article reporting that Austria warned that the remaining Gas flows out of Russia might get disrupted after a court ruling said that European companies no longer need to make payments to Gazprom on deliveries. Traders were pushing up Gas prices ahead of any disruption risk, but now profit-taking is underway and Gas prices are looking for support levels. The US Dollar Index (DXY), which tracks the Greenback's value against six major currencies, roughly trades flat after a volatile ride last week. A mixture of geopolitical events with mixed data has pushed the DXY back below 105.00. US markets are clo... For more info go to https://tinyurl.com/4k5fn94f

US power sector gas demand to peak in 2024 on renewables buildout Power sector gas demand in the US is expected to peak in 2024 thanks to a massive buildout of renewables that will offset rising power demand, including from data centers, S&P Global Commodity Insights analysts wrote in their latest short-term natural gas outlook. The outlook, which now includes 2029, forecasts a total decline of 12% in power sector gas demand by 2029 compared with 2023. "Even though net on-grid electricity demand is anticipated to grow robustly over 2023-2029, gas-fired generation is expected to decline as the US Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) promotes a surge in renewable capacity build," analysts wrote late May 23. Coal could also claw back some market share from gas from 2025 as higher gas prices "lead to a reversal of the coal to-gas switching happening in 2023-24," th... 




