

Prices Fall as Volatility Rises to 10 - 20 Cents per Day

U.S. natural gas prices are trending lower, reversing Tuesday's gains and facing increased volatility. Recent sessions show daily price movements of 10-20 cents, significantly higher than previous months. Despite higher demand and increased LNG exports, significant oversupply and production increases pressure prices downward. U.S. natural gas prices are trending lower on Wednesday, reversing Tuesday's gains following the first rally since last week's price reversal. Despite increased demand forecasts, market conditions remain volatile. At 13:12 GMT, Natural Gas futures are trading \$2.746, down \$0.079 or -2.80%. Daily volatility in the natural gas market has escalated, with daily trading ranges expanding significantly. Analysts see US gas storage surplus narrowing through late May

Market analysts expect another below-average build to US natural gas storage for the third week of May as warmer weather and stronger gas-fired power demand limited available supply for injection. According to the latest US gas storage survey from S&P Global Commodity Insights, the US Energy Information Administration will likely report a 78 Bcf injection to domestic inventory for the week to May 24. Estimates for EIA's upcoming storage print were reported in a relatively narrow range from 70-90 Bcf. Over 75% of the weekly estimates landed within an even narrower range from 75-85 Bcf. Assuming the latest survey prediction is accurate, the late May injection would undershoot the five-year average build of 104 Bcf and the year-ago stock addition 106 Bcf. Steady as Traders Weigh Production and Heat Trends

Natural gas futures decline as technical pressures and fundamental factors drive sell-offs. Last week, the EIA reported a 78 Bcf storage injection, below forecast, with production up amid higher prices. Heatwave boosts Texas power usage; cooler northern U.S. forecasts reduce gas demand. U.S. natural gas futures are flat on Tuesday after recovering from early session weakness. Coming off heavy selling late last week, natural gas futures were nearly unchanged early Tuesday as traders considered stronger production and mixed June forecast trends ahead of the front-month contract expiration. At 14:01 GMT, Natural Gas futures are trading \$2.518, unchanged. Last week, U.S. natural gas futures experienced a significant decline due to technical pressures and fundamental factors. 



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
