

Futures Mixed as Traders Await EIA Storage Report

Natural gas futures show mixed performance ahead of EIA storage report, pivoting around \$2.143 for direction. EIA storage report expected to show +13 Bcf build, influenced by cooling degree days and increased wind energy. High-pressure systems to drive temperatures into the 90s-100s, boosting natural gas demand across most of the US. EQT Corp. reaffirms 2024 sales volumes, signaling ongoing supply curtailments to balance the natural gas market. EQT CEO warns of "skyrocketing" prices if a fracing ban is implemented, stressing the impact on US production. Natural gas futures are showing mixed performance on Thursday as traders await the Energy Information Administration's (EIA) weekly storage report, scheduled for release at 14:30 GMT. European Natural Gas Prices Fall as Freeport LNG Resumes Operations

European natural gas prices fell sharply after the Freeport LNG export facility restarted operations. The restart of Freeport LNG eased concerns about supply shortages in Europe. European gas storage levels are high, reducing the risk of a gas crisis this winter. Europe's benchmark natural gas prices slumped on Monday to the lowest level in one week after the U.S. export facility Freeport LNG resumed some operations following a shutdown due to Hurricane Beryl earlier this month. The Dutch TTF Natural Gas Futures, the benchmark for Europe's gas trading, were down by 2.7% at \$34.09 (31.31 euros) per megawatt-hour (MWh) at 10:54 a.m. in Amsterdam on Monday. Last week, the supply disruptions from Freeport LNG and heat waves across a large part of Europe pushed up European natural gas prices. A... For more info go to https://tinyurl.com/bdzzsypb

Production at 101 Bcf/d - Can Demand Catch Up?

Natural gas futures fall for second consecutive session, erasing gains from previous three-day rally Production estimates steady at 101 Bcf/d, indicating abundant supply and putting downward pressure on prices Short-term outlook remains bearish despite choppy trading, with supply glut deterring higher summertime prices Natural gas futures are lower on Wednesday, continuing their downward trend for a second consecutive session. This decline follows a brief rally that saw the prompt month gain nearly 20 cents over three previous sessions. At 11:52 GMT, natural gas futures are trading \$2.128, down \$0.059 or -2.70%. Production estimates hold steady at around 101 Bcf/d, indicating abundant supply in the market. This high production level continues to be a key factor in pressuring prices downwar... 



UNDERGROUND WORKING NAT GAS STORAGE AS OF 07/12/2024 billion cubic feet



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
