

#### Hurricane Debby Impacting Futures, Inventory, and Market Forecast

Natural gas futures rise, testing \$1.907 support, as traders watch Hurricane Debby and mixed weather forecasts. Debby's aftermath and cooling demand in Southeast impact natural gas futures, causing market fluctuations. Canadian Natural Resources Ltd. slows gas production due to low prices, shifts focus to higher return oil wells. Hurricane Debby hits Southeast, threatens power outages and demand destruction, affecting futures prices. NWS predicts cooler temperatures in Northern Plains and Great Lakes, easing natural gas demand next week. Natural gas futures are showing a modest increase on Tuesday after successfully testing the key support level at \$1.907. Traders remain cautious as they monitor the aftermath of Hurricane Debby and mixed weather forecasts affecting cooling demand in the Southeast. At 13:14 GMT, Na... #### heat across Western US keep power, natural gas prices elevated

Excessive heat warnings are in effect across large portions of the Western US in the early part of this week, helping to keep wholesale electricity and natural gas prices elevated throughout the region. The US National Weather Service said in its short-range forecast Aug. 5 that the excessive heat warnings cover the Desert Southwest region and portions of California's central/southeastern California. A few major population areas are poised to see daily high temperatures in the 110s. Among notable areas in the West poised to see high temperatures above historical norms for this week are Las Vegas, Phoenix, Salt Lake City and Sacramento. Las Vegas' temperature was 112 degrees Fahrenheit Aug. 4 and forecast to average 108.9 degrees Aug. 5-11, about 5% hotter than the city's historical normal ... #### **Bearish Outlook Ahead Amid High Production and Hurricane Threat**

Natural gas futures fell to \$1.967, hitting multi-month lows despite high cooling demand due to ongoing heat. High production levels above 102 Bcf/d continue to overshadow weather-driven demand, pushing prices lower. ElA report shows smaller-than-expected build of 18 Bcf, but total storage remains well above last year's levels. ExxonMobil's Golden Pass LNG project delay to H2 2025 adds to bearish outlook, extending oversupply concerns. Hurricane Debby's potential impact on Gulf Coast could disrupt both demand and LNG production, adding uncertainty. The U.S. natural gas market faced strong downward pressure last week, with futures falling to multimonth lows. The market closed at \$1.967, down \$0.084 or -4.10%, after reaching an intraday low of \$1.920. This decline occurred despite intense h... For more info go to https://tinyurl.com/yjjbatwm




