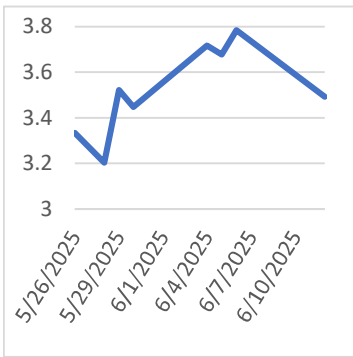

Market Rallies as LNG Supply Risks Stir Bullish Sentiment

Natural gas futures rose 2.55% as traders reacted to rising LNG risks and a bullish U.S. weather forecast for late June. A 6% jump in European gas prices followed Israel's strike on Iran, fueling fears of LNG disruption in the Strait of Hormuz. Above-normal U.S. temperatures forecast for June 23-27 may increase natural gas demand for electricity generation. Natural gas futures ended a four-day slide on Friday, with July Nymex contracts rising 2.55% to settle at \$3.581. The move was driven by renewed geopolitical risks and weather forecasts suggesting stronger near-term demand. Traders took cues from a rally in European gas prices and mounting concerns over global LNG flows, providing a short-term boost despite lingering supply headwinds. EU pushes back proposals to curb reliance on Russian nuclear fuel

LUXEMBOURG, June 16 (Reuters) - The European Commission will not propose measures to limit the EU's reliance on Russian nuclear fuel this week alongside its proposals to ban Russian gas, EU energy commissioner Dan Jorgensen said on Monday. The Commission is due to propose legal measures this week to end the EU's Russian gas imports by the end of 2027 - an aim the EU executive announced last month. The Commission had said it would also propose, in June, trade measures targeting enriched uranium, to make imports from Russia less attractive and encourage countries to switch to other suppliers. "That will also come, but in the first stage, we'll be focusing on the gas," Jorgensen told reporters on Monday, when asked about the timing of the nuclear proposals. Middle East Tensions Stoke Rally Across Energy Markets

WTI crude soared 13% intraday and closed 7% higher, fueled by Middle East supply fears and pipeline disruption risks. Natural gas bounced above its 50 and 200 EMA, but heavy selling near \$3.74 caps momentum below a descending trendline. Brent crude hovers near \$74.64 with resistance at \$75—sideways action signals indecision following a strong price rally. Crude oil futures extended gains Monday, with WTI rising to \$74.10 per barrel, as geopolitical tensions in the Middle East sparked fresh supply concerns. Friday's session saw oil prices surge over 13% intraday, closing 7% higher—the sharpest single-day gain in months—driven by fears of disruption across key energy infrastructure. 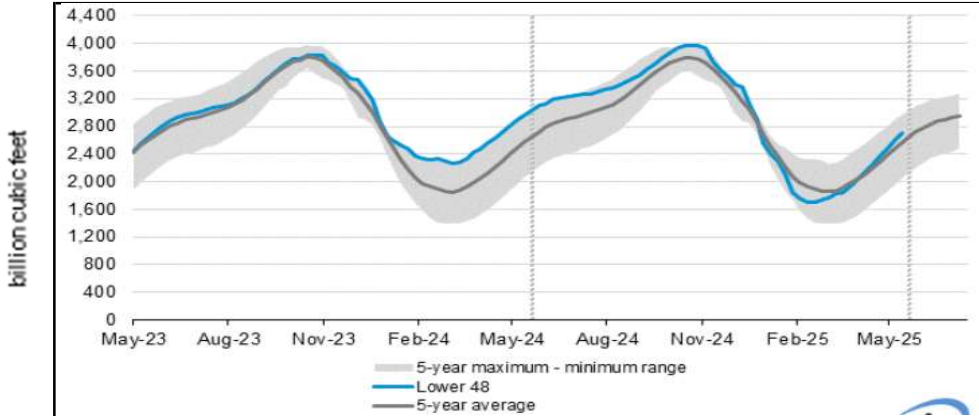

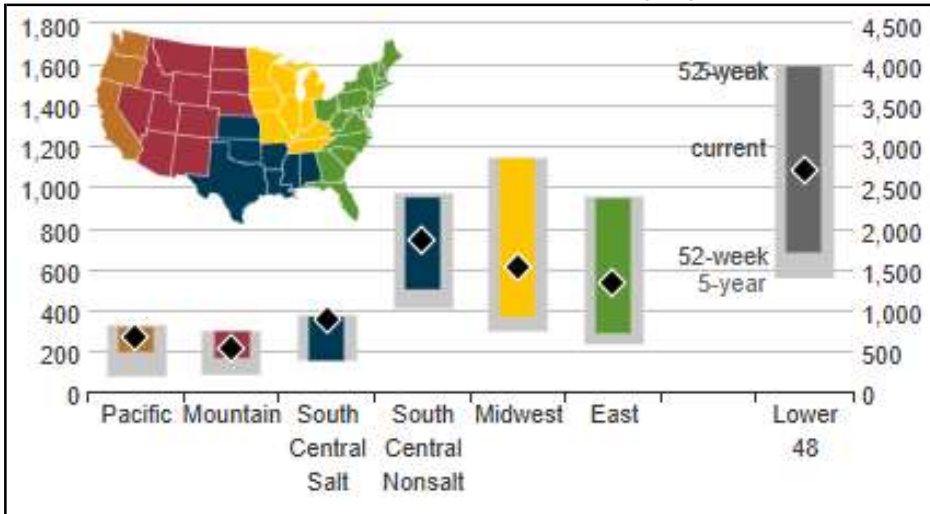

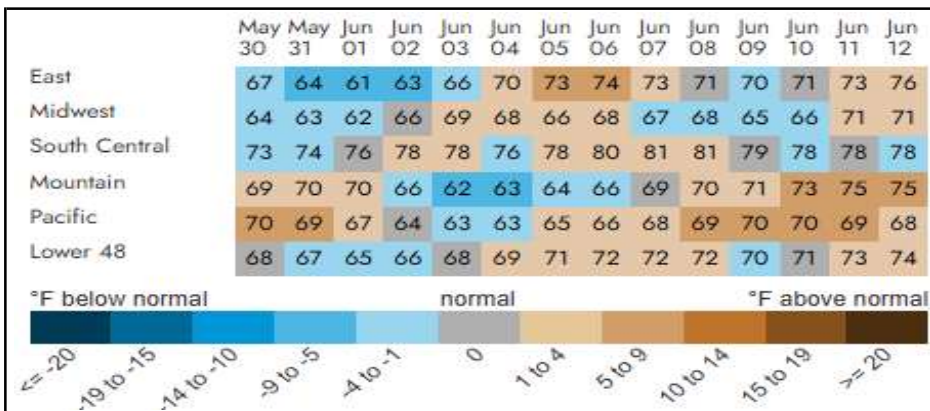

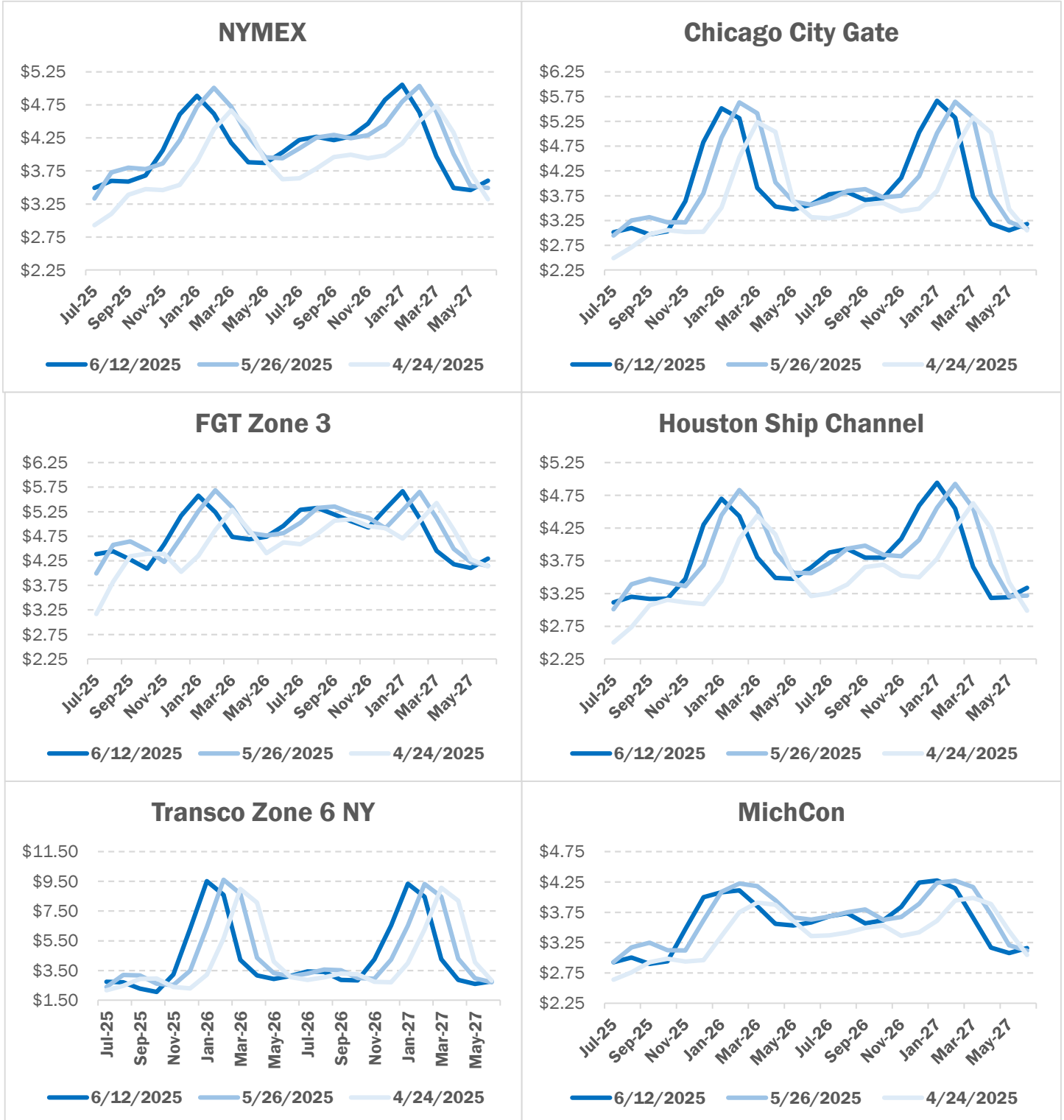

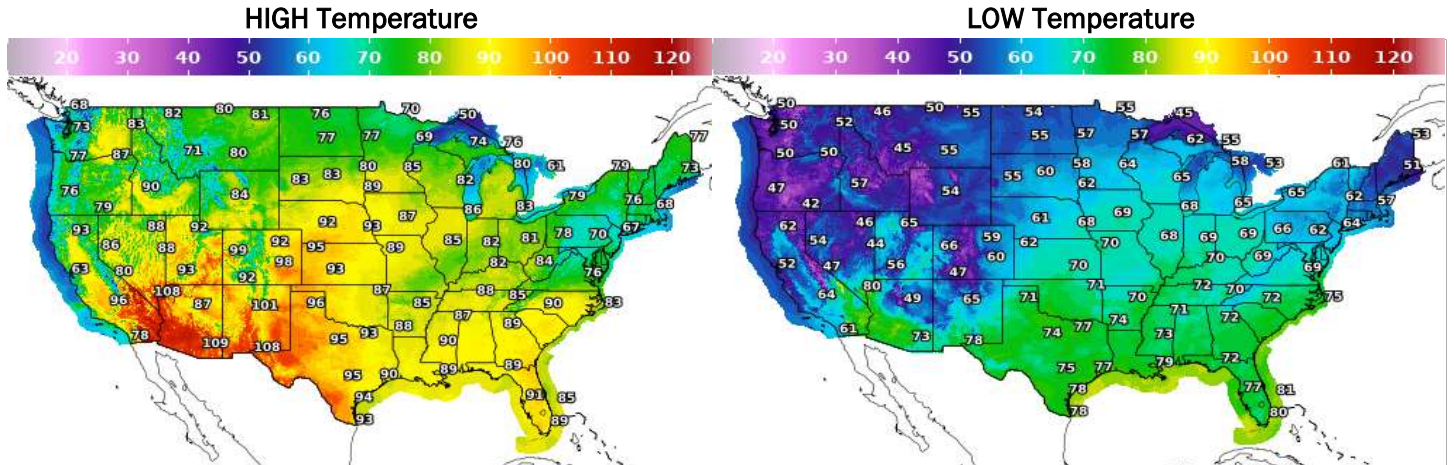
NATURAL GAS BASIS FUTURES



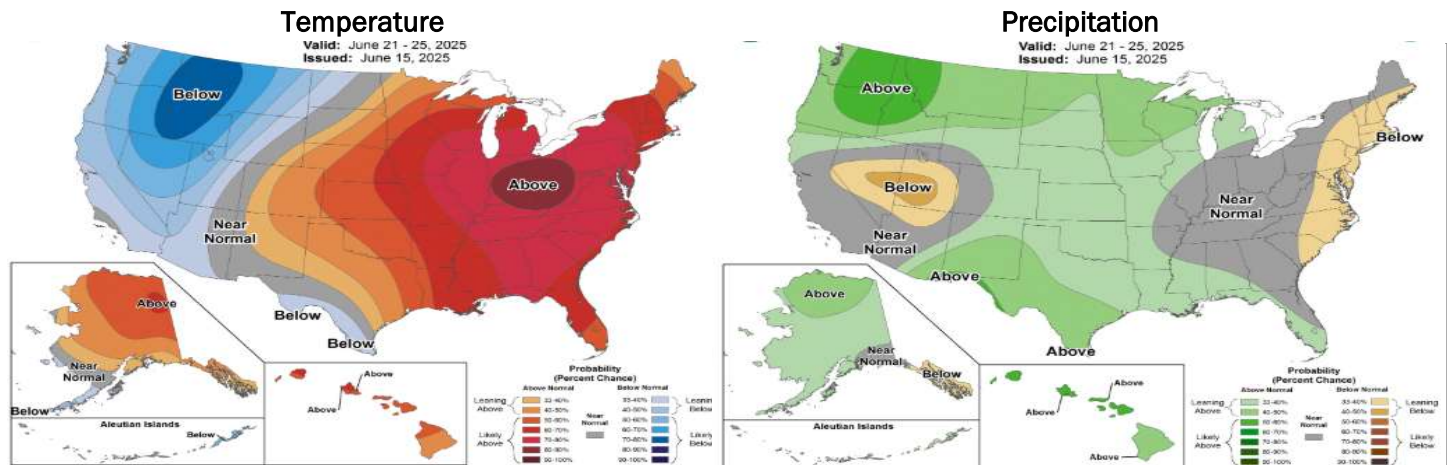
