U.S. natgas futures rise on record LNG exports, colder forecasts

U.S. natural gas futures rose nearly 2% on Friday on record liquefied natural gas (LNG) exports and a forecast for much colder weather and higher heating demand in two weeks' time. That price increase came despite a continued slow recovery in U.S. output from cold weather-related reductions earlier in the month and forecasts for less cold weather and lower heating demand next week than previously expected. Traders said the U.S. market continued to shrug off what was happening in the Europe gas market, where prices TRNLTFMc1 were down about 3%, due in part to a perceived easing in tensions between Russia and Ukraine. The United States has worked with other nations to ensure gas supplies, mostly LNG, would keep flowing to Europe if Russia cuts off exports there. Three countries provided almost 70% of liquefied natural gas received in E

In 2021, a large share of Europe's supply of liquefied natural gas (LNG) originated in the United States, Qatar, and Russia. Combined, these three countries accounted for almost 70% of Europe's total LNG imports, according to data by CEDIGAZ. The United States became Europe's largest source of LNG in 2021, accounting for 26% of all LNG imported by European Union member countries (EU-27) and the United Kingdom (UK), followed by Qatar with 24%, and Russia with 20%. In January 2022, the United States supplied more than half of all LNG imports into Europe for the month. Exports of LNG from the United States to EU-27 and the UK increased from 3.4 billion cubic feet per day (Bcf/d) in November 2021 to 6.5 Bcf/d in January 2022—the most LNG shipped to Europe from the United States on a monthly ba... Shell Sees LNG Demand Climbing By 90% Over Next 20 Years

Global liquefied natural gas demand is set to surge by 90 percent by 2040 compared to 2021 to exceed 700 million tons annually in two decades, as LNG and gas will continue to play an important role in energy supply, Shell, one of the top LNG traders, said in its annual industry outlook on Monday. LNG trade worldwide jumped by 6 percent in 2021 to 380 million tons as economies recovered from the pandemic, and shortages of energy supply led to record-high gas prices in Europe and Asia, Shell said. "Prices reached record levels in October 2021 as Europe, with historically low storage levels, struggled to secure LNG cargoes to meet expected winter gas demand," Shell said. Also last year, China surpassed Japan to become the biggest LNG importer in the world, with 79 million tons of the fuel imported, according to Shell... For more info go to <https://yhoo.it/3v6ih51>






WEEKLY GAS IN UNDERGROUND STORAGE WITH 5-YR RANGE






