

#### Price of natural gas could climb higher still after cresting multi-year highs

Summer heat waves could also push prices higher by driving up electricity demand. Natural gas prices could climb even higher, especially if hot weather boosts demand this summer. The rising price of oil may grab most of the headlines, but another commodity — natural gas — is on an even wilder ride and expected to hit fresh highs this summer. The war in Ukraine and resulting concerns about global energy security have driven up commodity prices world-wide. But where the price of oil is up about 85 per cent year-over-year, natural gas is up more than 200 per cent. #### Analysts say natural gas could go even higher after breaking 14-year recor

The rising price of oil may grab most of the headlines, but another commodity – natural gas – is on an even wilder ride and expected to hit fresh heights this summer. The war in Ukraine and resulting concerns about global energy security have driven up commodity prices worldwide. But where the price of oil is up about 85 per cent year-over-year, natural gas is up more than 200 per cent. As of mid-day Friday, the U.S. natural gas benchmark Henry Hub price was trading around US\$8.75 per million British thermal units, or MMBtu. It surged to a 14-year high of more than \$9 earlier in the week, from less than \$3 at this time last year. "It's like if oil went to \$200 (per barrel), but it's not getting the same kind of attention," said Dulles Wang, a Wood Mackenzie analyst based in Calgary. "An... #### Natural gas prices have nearly tripled in the US over the last year amid sup

Warmer than usual spring weather, expectations of a hotter summer, and record LNG exports to help Europe reduce dependence on Russian gas could send the U.S. benchmark natural gas prices to above \$10 per million British thermal units (MMBtu) in the coming weeks, analysts say. Earlier this week, the front-month Henry Hub benchmark price hit a 13-year high of over \$8/MMBtu, as prices rallied amid increased demand for air conditioning. As of 9:50 a.m. EST on Friday, the natural gas price was at \$8.693/MMBtu, down 1.02% on the day. Moreover, the levels of natural gas in storage across the United States are well below average for this time of the year. 




